**Scope and Content:**

**Series A 87/1/1-3** - film - 7 cm - 1948-1950

Three films taken by Mr. Eoll of:

- 1) Barbara Ann Scott's visit to Marathon, Ontario, c.1949, colour - 100 feet.
- 2) Fort William Rendevous celebration, c.1948 or 1950, colour - 250 feet.
- 3) Fort William Winter Carnival, 1949. Filmed and edited by G.K Eoll of Atikokan, Ontario, colour - 400 feet.

**Series A 87/2/1** - script - 1 cm - 1946

One script for a radio production written by student(s) of Fort William Collegiate Institute, probably in 1946. It is entitled "Fort William Collegiate Institute - 1966." The script is set in the future and shows students discussing the advantages their school has over that of their father's in 1946.

**Biographical Sketch:**

George K Eoll, teacher at Ogden School in Fort William from the mid 1930s to the mid 1940s. Later he was personnel manager for Marathon Paper Mills.
