

St. Joseph's Nurses Alumni Fonds

Scope and Content:

The St. Joseph's Nurses Alumni Fonds is composed of minute books, membership lists, cash books, and miscellaneous other documents pertaining to the organization. All are in good condition, and all are organized chronologically.

Series E 65/1/1-3: Minute books, 5 cm, 1966-1972 (original).

Minutes of meetings of the Nurses Alumni, from 1966 to its disbanding in 1972. It is in 3 books, and the first book also contains copies of the Alumni newsletter. All 3 books are in good condition.

Series E 65/2/1-2: Membership lists, 12 cm, 1907-1970 (original).

1) folder- lists of graduates for every year between 1907 and 1970, a program from the 1959 reunion, a copy of the Constitution (c. 1961), and a souvenir programme from the 1939 reunion. All in good condition, and organized chronologically.

2) Rolodex - lists of graduates and contact information (not complete), life members, and associate members. Contained in 1 box, and organized chronologically.

Series E 65/3/1-3: Cash books, 3 cm, 1956-1972 (original).

3 cash books of the St. Joseph's Nurses Alumni, from 1956-1972, showing both cash-in and expenditures of the organization for each year. Enclosed inside the books are receipts of donations, and several financial statements for the organization done by chartered accountants. They are handwritten, and all 3 are in good condition.

Series E 65/4/1-3: Miscellaneous, 5 cm, 1938-1972, 1984 (original).

1) Guest book from Centenary celebrations for St. Joseph's Hospital, hosted by the Nurses Alumni, June 24th, 1984. It is in excellent condition, and still in its original box.

2) Duotang containing planning information and patrons lists for the Alumni Dessert and Bridge, 1970-1972. Included also are the rules for the game, and a copy of a letter asking Alumni members to donate money to fund the 1970 Dessert Bridge.

3) pamphlets from graduation ceremonies (invitations as well), Alumni letterhead, and a student handbook for 1957. Organized chronologically, for the most part.

Biographical Sketch:

The declared mandate of the St. Joseph's Nurses Alumni was "the promotion of unity and goodwill among the graduates and the advancement of the profession of nursing". The Alumni disbanded in 1972, 5 years after the final intake of students to the St. Joseph's School of Nursing.
