Scope and Content: Contains research files, publications, clippings, articles, magazines, correspondence, and architectural sketches. The collection contains both originals and copies. The copies are mainly library books and microfilm prints. The collection is a compilation of Patricia Vervoort's own research, student research and the research of other organizations and friends. The research focus is on architecture and the historical preservation of architecture, but also has other miscellaneous topics.
