## Administrative history

The Citizen's League of West Fort William was established in January 1919 for the purpose of discussing affairs deemed to be "of importance to the community". The League operated on a non-partisan basis, and endeavoured to act as an advisory group to ward representatives on City Council. They discussed such issues as street repairs, public lighting, and railway crossings. R.S. Piper served as the first President.
