Organizational Sketch: The Co-op store in Nolalu was part of the co-op movement in Canada during this time. The secretaries of the Farmers' Mercantile Association were Alfred Zwap and Laina Maki. The Board of Directors included Laina Maki, R. Skogman, Alfred Zwap, and S. Gudmundson.
