Administrative history

The Fort William Police Protective Association was formed in Nov. 1946 for the purpose of applying to the Trades and Labor Congress of Canada to form a union. The organization sought to act as a bargaining unit in negotiations with the City of Fort William. In April 1947 the association was transformed into the Fort William Police Association for the same purposes. It amalgamated with the Fort William Police Athletic Club in 1950. (see <u>E 60</u>)
