Notice offering a reward of one hundred dollars to anyone who could bring "a dangerous Indian Lunatic" in the vicinity of Fort William to the judicial authorities at Sault Ste. Marie.

## **Biographical Sketch**:

This series was produced by the Provincial Secretary's office, William McDougall. William McDougall was provincial secretary for Lord Monck in 1864. As minister of public works in J.A. MacDonald's government (1867), McDougall introduced the resolution that led the purchase of Rupert's Land. He was appointed first Lieutenant-Governor of the North West Territories in 1869.
