Scope and Content: The Port Arthur Collegiate Institute fonds consists of three series with items ranging from letters and memoranda, to attendance records and account books.

Series G 13/1/1: Letters/Memoranda - 3 cm - 1969 (originals).

Official letters and memoranda to various individuals and institutions from P.A.C.I. principal (J.A. Cottenden) and vice-principal (W.T. La Belle). Subjects concern a range of school business such as requests to the Board of Education and letters to parents concerning a student's attendance, academic record or behaviour.

Series G 13/2/1: Records and Attendance - 7 cm - 1918-1941 (originals). This series contains a ledger with examination records of P.A.C.I. students; grades differentiated into three categories, lower, middle, and upper; date of examinations, students' names, subjects taught, final mark and students' overall rank for each year; and attendance records from 1918-1935.

 - 1) Ledger, 35 p, used for P.A.C.I.'s board fund accounts (July 1940-December 31, 1948).
 - 2) Ledger, 35 p, used for P.A.C.I.'s school fun accounts(May 1, 1941-July 26, 1944).
 - 3) Ledger, 152 p, petty cash book (1961-1974).
