The Lake Superior Chapter, I.O.D.E., was formed in November 1909, out of a meeting of the Women's Canadian Club. It furnished a four bed wing of McKellar Hospital, worked with boys' auxiliary classes, Boy Scouts, and Sea Cadets. The chapter was disbanded officially early in 1976.
