Biographical Sketch

Jean Crittall, collector, researcher and promoter of local theatre and arts, and Gisela Depkat, cellist, b. in Koenigsberg, Germany in Sept. 1942 and came to Thunder Bay in 1954. Depkat studied in Germany (Hamburg) and the U.S.A. (Oberlin College, Ohio). She won first prize in the 1964 International Music Competition in Geneva.

Scope and Content

The Jean Crittall collection contains material produced and collected by Ms. Crittall. It is composed of four series and relate generally to music and the performing arts at the Lakehead. The records also pertain directly to the career of Gisela Depkat, cellist, and to the Port Arthur Woman's Club.

The correspondence of Mrs. Jean Crittall primarily concerning Gisela Depkat, cellist. Most letters are from Depkat to Crittall. Arrangement is chronological. The subject is Miss Depkat's career in music. Undated letter and envelopes are also included along with a biographical sketch of Miss Depkat.
