Administrative history

The Kaministikwia Club of Fort William was established in 1903 as a non-political, and non-sectarian social organization for men. It was incorporated in 1906. J.T. Horne was a founding member and served as an officer of the club from 1903 to 1919. The club does not appear to have connection with the Kaministiquia Club which was formed in 1879 for business and social purposes.

Scope and Content

The Kaministikwia Club fonds is composed of annual reports, letters and handbooks regarding the club, its meetings, and its activities. All are in chronological order.
