Series E 73/6/1: Miscellaneous - 1 cm - c. 1954-2000 (originals).

A collection of miscellaneous items, such as the club's history to 1954, observations from 1977, and the 1980s, exhibition winner from 1961-2000, the Don Jack award 1943-1989, Northwestern Ontario postal codes, a glossary of philatelic terms, and logo contest entries.

Series E 73/7/1: Memberships - 9 cm - c. 1959-1991 (originals).

A collection of membership records with a page for each member indicating their years of membership.

Organizational Sketch: The Club was first created in 1947 with roughly 12 members. The Lakehead chapter, Chapter 33 of The Royal Philatelic Society of Canada, began as a group in 1954 and has managed to maintain its role to this very day. The members of the Club meet two times a month from September until June, on the second Wednesday and the last Friday of every month. The meetings include slide programmes, discussions, guest speakers, and sometimes even auctions. An annual exhibition occurs every year for the group members to participate in. When the club first formed a membership cost \$5.00, whereas today a membership costs \$10.00. Spouses and children under 16 are \$2.00, which has stayed the same since the formation of the club.
