Organizational Sketch: The North Western Ontario Film Federation (1955-1967) was created to replace the Thunder Bay Film Council, which was founded in 1946. Both organizations distributed films, particularly N.F.B. films, throughout North Western Ontario through the N.F.B.'s regional representative, Will Dougall, based at Fort William Public Library. The N.W.O.F.F. dissolved in 1967 upon Dougall's retirement, and responsibility for distribution of N.F.B. films passed to the North Western Regional Library Co-operative.
