Administrative history

P.H. and P. Company, a hardware wholesale and retail store, was situated in the Bee Hive Block in West Fort William, and was organized on 10 May 1905 by the owners T.M. Piper, W.F. Hogarth and R.S.. Piper. Samuel D. Cashmore was the store manager. By 1910, according to the directories, the store was called the R.S. Piper Company with R.S. Piper as the proprietor and it was located on 1515 Brown Street.
