Anniversary celebration booklets, financial and administrative information regarding the Ladies' Aid (taken from Series 1 books to protect the papers from damage as most are bigger than the books they had been in).

Organizational Sketch:

Built in 1908 the Railway, Marine, and General Hospital was one of the principal hospitals in Port Arthur. It was replaced by the Port Arthur General in 1918, which saw many extensive renovations throughout the years. When medical care was centralized in 2004 Port Arthur General was closed down. It was demolished in 2010.
