Scope and Content:

The Port Arthur General School of Nursing Training Records is composed of two report books detailing both training and marks received by nurses during the periods 1909-1935 and 1942-1947.

Series E 62/1/1: Report book, 4 cm, 1909-1935 (original).

Recording of marks, examination dates, training received by nurses between 1909-1935. Also lists dates of graduation or dismissal from program, and occasionally the reasons for this action. The report book is organized chronologically, with the exception of the lists of examination results (c.1911-1914), and several entries regarding staff appointments from this period which appear at the end of the book.

Series E 62/1/2: Log book, 4 cm, 1942-1947 (original).

Attendance records for each month of training between February 1942 and February 1947. Reasons for student nurses' absence from training (e.g. sickness, finished training) are also occasionally noted. The report book is organized chronologically.

Biographical Sketch:

The School of Nursing, located originally at the Railway, Marine and General Hospital (the name changed in 1918) started operations in 1909. It changed locations along with the Port Arthur General Hospital in 1930, and operated on its premises until 1967.
