Administrative history

The Port Arthur Shipbuilding Company was originally the Western Dry Dock and Shipbuilding Company Ltd. of Port Arthur, Ontario. In May of 1909 the company entered into a construction agreement with the city of Port Arthur (by-law, 1910 #348). In 1916, the Port Arthur Shipbuilding Company or PASCO. was incorporated to purchase and take over the assets of the Western Dry Dock and Shipbuilding Company according to another city by-law, 1917 #1504. Once fully established the company built ships of all types including war vessels in both World Wars, pulp and paper machinery, and commercial boilers. The company also operated as a dry dock facility for repairing and docking ships. As well it was authorized to carry on warehousing and storage so as to acquire licenses for the establishment of steamship lines.

Scope and Content

Legal records, financial statements, accounts, journals, order books, order sheets and files belonging to the Port Arthur Shipbuilding Company. These record the business and financial aspects of the company. There are eight series in this collection.
