Biographical Sketch

Rev. S.C. Murray (1857-1945) was minister of St. Paul's Presbyterian church in Port Arthur from 1893 to 1911. He was a Christian Socialist actively involved in the local labour movement. He was also convener of the Home Mission Committee of the Presbyterian Church of Canada and chairman of the Educational Committee of the Port Arthur Board of Education.
