Organizational Sketch:

The Lakehead Chapter of the SMA was one of the first chapters of its kind. The SMA began with branches in Toronto, Montreal, and Hamilton, and expanded to Winnipeg and Vancouver until the Depression caused the latter two to be dissolved. During the late 1930s the organization expanded to Niagara, Kitchener and London. By 1938 the plans existed to expand into Windsor, Winnipeg, Vancouver, the Lakehead region, Calgary and possibility Edmonton. The Lakehead Region did gain a branch in 1938 with the first meeting held in December of that year.
