A wide range of documents involved in the Healthy Horizons/Herizons project.

E 87/8/1-13: What Can I Do?, 2cm, 19880-1989

A project to try to get the public mobilized around healthcare reforms. Contains correspondence, board meeting minutes, and various other documents.

Funding requests made to various organizations and government programmes.

E 87/10/1-14: Project Out-Of-Town Birth, 9cm, 1987-1990

The P.O.B. was an effort to improve education for women giving birth away from larger urban centres and medical facilities. Documents include various administrative papers (such as funding efforts) and information booklets.

Contains a range of documents, mostly administrative. Involves a play called *Crane Dance*.

A general overview of women's health activities in Northwester Ontario.

E 87/13/1-111: Medical Information, 60.5cm, 1980-1982

Introductory information pages on a wide range of medical options from acupuncture to caesareans.
